## **Other Important Reminders**

SIGNING IN AND OUT: As you know, we are regulated by the Department of Family and Protective Services. Children are required to be signed in and out EACH day. If you participate in carpool your child will be signed in/out for you. If you bring your child in and/or come in to pick your child up it is extremely important that you sign him/her in and out. **2015-2016 ENROLLMENT:** Enrollment contracts for the 2015-2016 school year will go out February 10<sup>th</sup> and are due back February 27<sup>th</sup>. We will open enrollment to the general public March 2<sup>nd</sup>. We have a number of students on the waiting list and we will begin placing them in classrooms on March 2<sup>nd</sup> so please be sure and turn your contracts in by the deadline, we do not want you to lose your spot!

**REFERRAL PROGRAM:** Don't forget our referral program. If you refer a student to OFMS you will receive a \$300 credit on your account. Please call the office for details.

**PARENT CONFERENCES:** Parent Conference forms will go out on February 4<sup>th</sup> and are due back by February 11<sup>th</sup>. Parents fill these forms out with their preferred conference time and we do our best to accommodate. The sooner you turn your forms in the better chance you have of getting your preferred time. Please make every effort to attend. We want to make sure you know how your child is doing. <u>Conferences are on February 16<sup>th</sup> so please mark your calendars. OFMS WILL BE</u> <u>CLOSED.</u> Childcare will be available for your child during your conference period.

MARCH LUNCH ORDER FORMS: March lunch order forms will go out on Tuesday, February 17<sup>th</sup> and are due back on Tuesday, February 24<sup>th</sup>. Please remember late orders cannot be accepted. There will be no lunch delivery on March 4<sup>th</sup> due to the pizza party. If your child has an allergy or does not eat pizza please feel free to send a special lunch.

**LABELING:** Parents, please be sure ALL of your child's clothing is labeled. This includes coats, gloves, hats, EXTERIOR of lunch kits, nap items. These things are expensive and we want to make sure they make it back home! We have a number of items in our Lost and Found. If you are missing something please stop by the office.
